In conjunction with the exhibition *Craigie Horsfield: Relation*, generationnext is providing a platform for teenagers to express their creativity and self identity through photography.

The theme 'Timely Exposure' was developed by the generationnext youth committee who feel that it will enable their fellow teenagers to understand the influences of Horsfield and will also highlight the amazing talent of tomorrow's rising stars.

The work of Craigie Horsfield, amongst other things, focuses on his immediate environment and the notion of time. Horsfield feels that by taking a photo we enter into a conversation and says his work creates opportunity for "attention to the telling of lives in which each of us are conscious of our part". Craigie Horsfield wants entrants to understand that their work will form part of a larger conversation and exchange with the viewer when they display their work at generationnext.

Competition Guidelines

1. The competition is open to **any** teenager in years 7-12 at school – whether you study art at school or not.
2. **You don't have to be a superstar photographer to enter – just point and shoot!**
3. Photographs may be taken on any form of photographic device including mobile phone, digital and SLR cameras.
4. Photos may include more than one person.
5. If printing at home, the paper must be at least **120 gsm** thick.
6. Works must fit the following standard sizes:
 - a. 4 x 6 (10.2 x 15.3cm)
 - b. 5 x 7 (12.7 x 17.8cm)
 - c. A4 (20 x 28cm)
7. A hard copy of the photographs must be sent to the Museum, titled '**generationnext photography**' no later than **Thursday 22 March**. The Museum's postal address is **PO Box R1286, Royal Exchange NSW 1223**
8. An electronic copy must be sent via email to generationnext@mca.com.au with the email title generationnext photography no later than **Thursday 22 March**.
9. Both hard and electronic photos must be accompanied by a fully completed entry form that can be downloaded from www.mca.com.au/generationnext or copied from this document.
10. Every photograph entered will be displayed at the generationnext event; however generationnext reserves the right to not display any work that is deemed unsuitable.
11. All work entered will be judged by a professional photographer, three generationnext members and a mystery judge.
12. There will be prizes awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place and viewers' choice. No correspondence will be entered into.
13. The winning entries and other selected shots will be displayed on the MCA website www.mca.com.au/generationnext and www.myspace.com/genextmca

The work will be displayed at the generationnext event (timely exposure) on Sunday 25th March from 6-8pm.
