

MCA BELLA PROGRAM: FACT SHEET

When does the Bella season run? Bella season runs from 1 September – 17 December

Who can participate in the Bella program? Students aged 5 to 18 year olds with physical, intellectual, behavioural or sensory disabilities, or those who are disadvantaged due to social or financial risk factors.

Who delivers the Bella program? MCA Learning has a team of experienced Art Educators trained in teaching students with specific needs. All staff are trained in disability awareness and are practicing artists or educators.



How large are the group sizes? The participant ratio is 1 educator to 3-10 students, depending on the specific needs of participants. Talk to MCA Learning about your students requirements.

How long do Bella sessions run for? Each Bella session runs for 90 minutes, but can be adapted depending on the needs of your students.

How much does Bella cost? It is FREE. The Bella season is about providing students with disabilities greater access to gallery based art education programs.

What times and days does the Bella program operate? The Bella program runs every week day during the period of 1 September – 17 December. We offer two session times, 10.00-11.30am or 12.30-2.00pm.
